

Before You Turn That Bull Out for Breeding..

Remember that all bulls must be sired verified before you can register calves out of them, therefore, it is extremely important that you remember to pull tail hair on all herd sires before turning them out for breeding, unless you are certain they already have genotype on file with the CLA.

For those of you selling bulls, it has proven to be useful practice for breeders to pull tail hair on all bulls they are selling and keep it in separate well labelled envelopes. You could just save the day when a buyer finds themselves in a pickle and is trying to register calves out of a bull that is gone and they neglected to sire verify.

Submit Your Yearling Data

It cannot be emphasised enough how important it is to collect data on your herd and report that data to the CLA! This benefits both you and your herd, and the entire Association and Limousin breed!

The following information is to be collected at yearling 270 - 500 days of age (minimum 60 days post weaning):

Yearling Weight, Scrotal Circumference, Carcass Ultrasound (Ultrasound barnsheet available on DigitalBeef under Herd Mgmt - Recording - Barnsheet)
